Nowadays English has played an important role in the massive means of communication.


Learning to speak English may be the best way to improve our lives.



I've learned new words that I didn't know before. I've learned to communicate in the public areas. I've learned to find information faster. I've learned to study smarter. The last thing I've learned is that


1. I improved my pronunciation.
